APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The Live Like Lucas Foundation sponsors scholarships awarded to high school seniors who have made a positive impact to the special needs' community. For 2026, a \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student that has made outstanding contributions to the special needs community. This Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Demonstrated outstanding contributions to the special needs' community. Examples include volunteering in Special Buddy programs, worked at a special needs' facility and community involvement with special needs children and/or adults.
- Typed essay (1 page) describing how he/she contributed to the special needs community and how it affected them.

Other considerations include:

- Letter of recommendation pertaining to your potential success while working with special needs children/adults. This letter can be from a teacher, community leader, counselor, pastor, employer, etc. who can attest to your work with special needs individuals.

The Live Like Lucas Scholarship application process:

- A Scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00 will be awarded based on criteria and considerations listed above.
- The Scholarship winner will be notified via email and posted on social media and our website.
- Payment of scholarship funds will be made directly to the recipient after awarded.
- All completed scholarship applications are **due to the Live Like Lucas Foundation no later than May 15, 2026.**
